## Flame performs in Indiana

JOHNSTOWN — Flame returned to Johnstown May 10 after a four-day trip to South Bend, Ind., where the group performed at a sold-out concert at Indiana University.

Flame, whose members have disabilities, was hired by the Chiara Home, a South Bend agency providing residential supports for people with developmental disabilities who paid all their expenses, a news release said.

The band drove its tour bus to Indiana and made stops in Cleveland and Buffalo. This year's tour includes performances in 45

towns and seven states. Flame will leave for Washington, D.C., on June 7 to perform at a dinner at a national conference.

As Flame's tour calendar fills up, the group has turned down many requests due to scheduling conflicts and logistics, including offers to play in Nigeria and Los Angeles, according to the news release.
